

# Barnyard



Quilt designed by Janet Houts for Blank Quilting  
Finished Size is 70" x 70"

Block Size: 12"

All seam allowances are 1/4". Please read all directions before beginning and press carefully after each step.

## Fabric Requirements:

**Fabric A:** 1 yd of 5117 Multi

**Fabric B:** 1/2 yd of 5118 White

**Fabric C:** 1/2 yd of 5120 Pink

**Fabric D:** 1-1/8 yds of 5122 Ivory

**Fabric E:** 1-1/8 yds of 5122 Rust

**Fabric F:** 3/4 yd of 5119 Yellow

**Fabric G:** 3/4 yd of 5121 Tan

**Fabric H:** 1/2 yd of 3504 Meadow

**Fabric I:** 3/8 yd of 3504 Cocoa

**Binding:** 5/8 yd 3504 Meadow

Cut (8) 2-1/4" strips

**Backing:** 4-1/3 yds 5122 Ivory

Cut and piece fabric to fit

quilt top with 4" overlap

## Cutting Directions:

**Fabric A:** Cut (9) 10-1/2" squares

**Fabric B:** Cut (8) 6-1/2" squares

**Fabric C:** Cut (8) 6-1/2" squares

**Fabric D:** Cut (8) 7-1/4" squares (cut in half on diagonal twice to make 32 quarter-square triangles)

Cut (16) 6-7/8" squares (cut in half on diagonal once to make 32 half-square triangles)

**Fabric E:** Cut (8) 7-1/4" squares (cut in half on diagonal twice to make 32 quarter-square triangles)

Cut (16) 6-7/8" squares (cut in half on diagonal once to make 32 half-square triangles)

**Fabric F:** Cut (12) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

**Fabric G:** Cut (8) 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

Cut (4) 4-1/2" squares

**Fabric H:** Cut (18) 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips

Cut (18) 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips

**Fabric I:** Cut (4) 4-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" strips

Cut (2) 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" strips

## Barnyard Block:

1. Sew two 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" Fabric H strips to sides of one 10-1/2" Fabric A square.

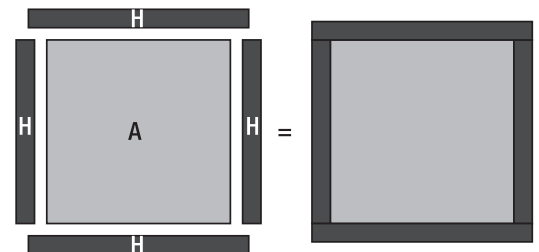


Figure 1—Barnyard Block

2. Sew two 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric H strips to top and bottom of same square (fig. 1). Make nine 12-1/2" blocks.

## Square-in-a-Square Block:

3. Sew two Fabric E quarter-square triangles to sides of one 6-1/2" Fabric C square. Sew remaining two triangles to top and bottom of square.

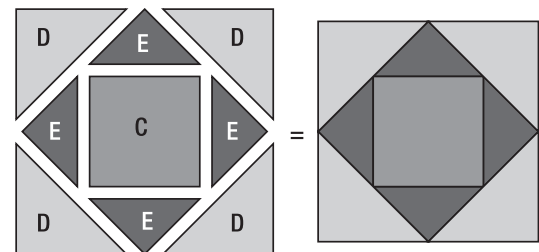


Figure 2—Square-in-a-Square Block (pigs)

4. Sew two Fabric D half-square triangles to sides of step 3 square. Sew remaining two triangles to top and bottom of to complete the block (fig. 2). Make eight 12-1/2" pigs blocks.

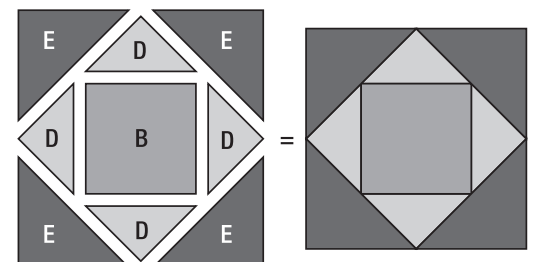


Figure 3—Square-in-a-Square Block (cows)

5. Repeat steps 3 and 4, using 6-1/2" Fabric B square, Fabric D quarter-square triangles, and Fabric E half-square triangles (fig. 3). Make eight 12-1/2" cows blocks.

## Row Assembly:

6. Sew the Barnyard and Square-in-a-Square blocks into five rows of five blocks each, referring to the quilt photograph as a guide for block placement. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.

## Borders:

7. Alternate sewing three 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric F strips to two 4-1/2" x 12-1/2" Fabric G strips, beginning with Fabric F. Make four 60-1/2" pieced border strips.
8. Sew 1-1/2" x 4-1/2" Fabric I strips to one side of a 4-1/2" Fabric G square. Make four cornerstone units.
9. Sew two 1-1/2" x 60-1/2" Fabric I strips to sides of quilt top.
10. Sew two 4-1/2" x 60-1/2" pieced border strips to sides of quilt top.
11. Sew two 1-1/2" x 70-1/2" Fabric I strips to top and bottom of quilt top.
12. Watching orientation, sew cornerstone units to each end of remaining pieced border strips and attach these strips to top and bottom of the quilt top.

## Finishing:

Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
