Fabric Requirements:

Brite Version

Fabric A: 1/2 yard of BTR-M4825 Brite
Fabric B: 3/4 yard of BTR-M4827 Cherry
Fabric C: 3/4 yard of BTR-M4827 Black
Fabric D: 1-1/4 yard of BTR-M3708 Navy
Fabric E: 1 yard of BTR-M3708 Cardinal
Fabric F: 1-1/4 yard of BTR-M4826 Brite
Fabric G: 1/4 yard of BTR-M3708 Onyx
Backing: 3-1/2 yards of BTR-M4825 Brite
Fusible Web: 1 yard

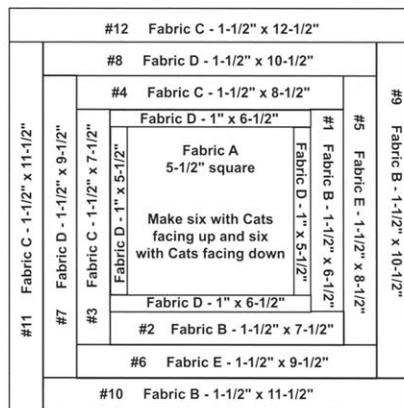
Fabric A: 1/2 yard of BTR-M4825 Spice
Fabric B: 3/4 yard of BTR-M4827 Grape
Fabric C: 3/4 yard of BTR-M4827 Moss
Fabric D: 1-1/4 yard of BTR-M3708 Pistachio
Fabric E: 1 yard of BTR-M3708 Fuschia
Fabric F: 1-1/4 yard of BTR-M4826 Spice
Fabric G: 1/4 yard of BTR-M3708 Onyx
Backing: 3-1/2 yards of BTR-M4825 Spice
Fusible Web: 1 yard

Cutting Directions:

- Fabric A:** Cut twelve 5-1/2" squares
Fabric B: Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips, twelve 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips, twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" and twelve 1-1/2" x 6-1/2" strips.
Fabric C: Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 12-1/2" strips, twelve 1-1/2" x 11-1/2" strips, twelve 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips and twelve 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" strips.
Fabric D: Cut twenty-four 1" x 5-1/2" strips, twenty-four 1" x 6-1/2" strips, twelve 1-1/2" x 10-1/2" strips and twelve 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips. Cut two 2" x 39-1/2" strips. Cut three 2" x width of fabric (WOF) strips. Piece the strips together into two 2" x 48-1/2" strips.
Fabric E: Cut twelve 1-1/2" x 9-1/2" strips and twelve 1-1/2" x 8-1/2" strips. Cut six 2-1/4" x WOF strips for the binding.
Fabric F: Cut six 5-1/2" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together into two 5-1/2" x 51-1/2" strips and two 5-1/2" x 49-1/2" strips.
Fabric G: See applique instructions to trace and cut twenty paw prints.
Backing: Sew into one 57" x 69" piece for the backing.

Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- Sew one 1" x 5-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of each 5-1/2" Fabric A square.
Sew one 1" x 6-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the 5-1/2" Fabric A squares to make twelve Block Centers.
- Follow the block layout to sew the Fabric B, C, D and E strips to the Block Centers following the numbers on the Block layout for the order in which to sew the strips to the Block Center. Sew six blocks with the Block Center facing up and six blocks with the Block Center facing down.
- Refer to the quilt photo and sew the blocks together into four rows.
Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
- Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace twenty cat paw prints onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out the shapes and press to the back side of Fabric G. Cut out each shape on the drawn line.
- Refer to the quilt photo for placement and press each paw print to the quilt top.
Finish the raw edges with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch.
- Sew one 2" x 48-1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top.
Sew one 2" x 39-1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Sew one 5-1/2" x 51-1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top.
Sew one 5-1/2" x 49-1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
