DECADENT VICTORIAN QUILT:

Elaborate flower gardens with gazing balls, ornate painted ladies with gingerbread trim and Edwardian gowns - celebrate the era by making this quilt using strip piecing, seminole piecing and easy corner triangles.



CUTTING:



Rose-Solid 35011-31

Cut 5-4 1/4" x WOF
then cut 80-4 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Sage-Solid 35011-32

Cut 3-10" x WOF
then cut 18-10" x 5 1/4"
1-8 3/4" x 22"

Cut 3-4" x WOF"
then cut 42-4" x 2 1/2"

Cut 3-22" x WOF
then cut 15-3 3/4" x 22"
13-3 1/4" x 22"
and 4-3 1/2" x 3 1/2"

Cut 12-3" x WOF"

Cut 1-3 1/4" x WOF
then cut 3-3 1/4" x 11"

Cut 2-13" x WOF
then cut 5-13" x 13"
cut in half twice diagonally
2-7" x 7" cut in half diagonally

Cut 5-2 1/2" x WOF
then cut 80-2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



Sage-Mini Polka Dot 35024-32

Cut 1-3 3/4" x WOF
then cut 2-3 3/4" x 22"

Cut 1-3 1/4" x WOF
then cut 3-3 1/4" x 11"



Plum-Mini Polka Dot 35024-34

Cut 10-2 1/2" x WOF
then cut 160-2 1/2" x 2 1/2"



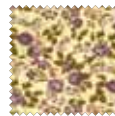
Plum-Decadent Rose 35070-14

Cut 4-3 1/4" x WOF
then cut 4-3 1/4" x 22"
2-3 1/4" x 11"

Cut 3-2 1/2" x WOF

Final border:

Cut 8-5 1/2" x WOF final border if pieced
or
Cut 4-5 1/2" x 80" if one length

Cut 3-4 1/2" x WOF
then cut 20-4 1/2" x 4 1/2"



Rose-Flower Toss 35073-11

Cut 5-3 1/4" x WOF
then cut 9-3 1/4" x 22"
1-3 1/4" x 11"

Cut 3-2 1/2" x WOF



Plum-Jamavor 35074-14

Cut 4-3 1/4" x WOF
then cut 8-3 1/4" x 22"

Binding

Cut 8-2 1/2" x WOF

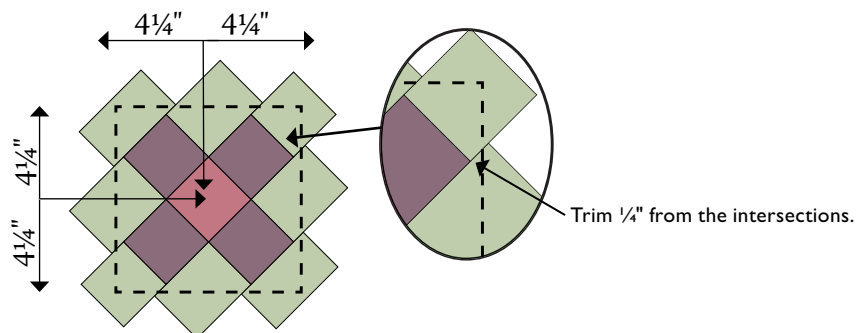
HINT:

Four blocks in this quilt are made using strip piecing. The blocks are then trimmed to measure 8 1/2" x 8 1/2". The edges are now on the bias. Spraying the fabrics with spray starch before cutting will help keep these edges from warping.

TRIMMING:

When trimming the blocks, start from the center of the block and measure 4 1/4" from all sides of the center. Trim the blocks to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2".

Trim 4 1/4" on each side of the block center.

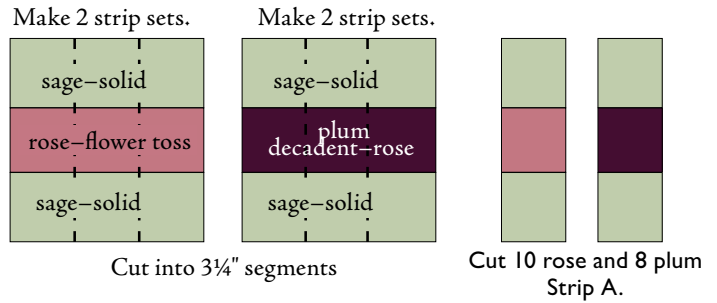


CONSTRUCTION:

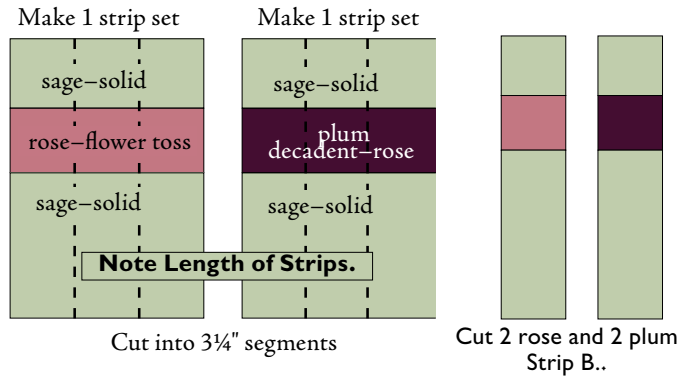
STRIP PIECING THE BLOCKS:

Sew together the strip sets and cut them into $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Combine the different strips to make the different blocks. Trim the blocks to $8\frac{1}{2}$ "x $8\frac{1}{2}$ ". Press away from the sage–solid whenever possible.

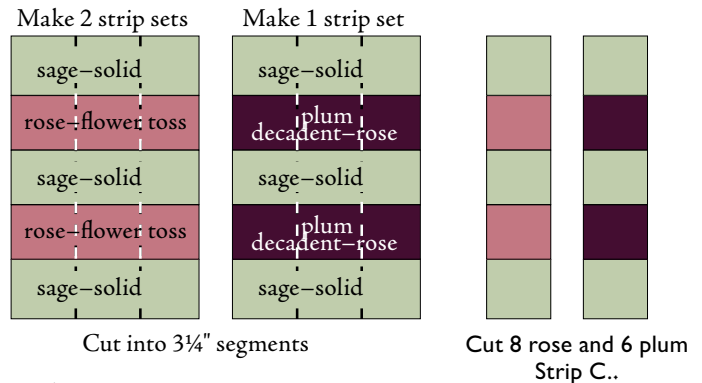
- 1** Sew two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips to one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " rose–flower toss strip. **Make 2 strip sets.** Cut into (10) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Then sew two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips to one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " plum–decadent–rose strip. **Make 2 strip sets.** Cut into (8) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Cut a total of 18 Strip A



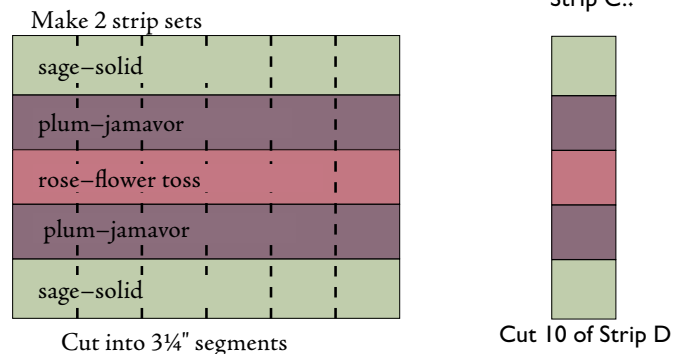
- 2** Sew one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 11 " sage–solid strip, one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 11 " plum–decadent–rose strip and one $8\frac{3}{4}$ "x 11 " sage–solid strip. **Make 1 strip set.** Cut into (2) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Then sew one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 11 " sage–solid strip, one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 11 " rose–flower toss strip and one $8\frac{3}{4}$ "x 11 " sage–solid strip. **Make 1 strip set.** Cut into (2) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Cut a total of 4 Strip B



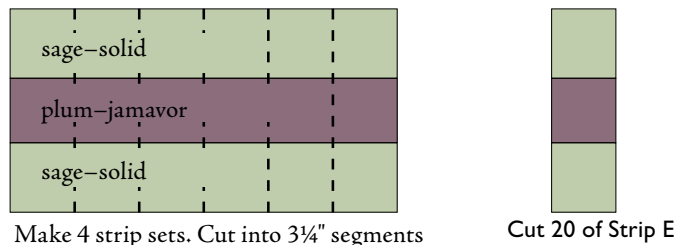
- 3** Sew three $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips, and two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " plum–decadent–rose strips. **Make 1 strip set.** Cut into (6) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Then sew three $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips, and two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " rose–flower toss strips. **Make 2 strip sets.** Cut into (8) $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Cut a total of 14 Strip C



- 4** Sew two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips, one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " rose–flower toss strip and two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " plum–jamavor strips. **Make 2 strip sets.** Cut onto $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Cut 10 of Strip D

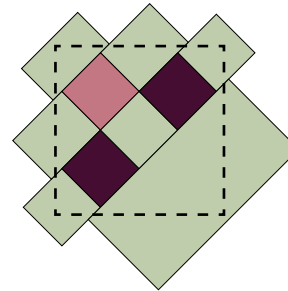
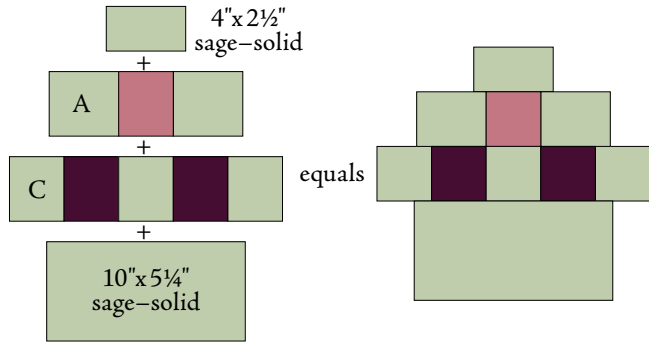


- 5** Sew together two $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " sage–solid strips to one $3\frac{1}{4}$ "x 22 " plum–jamavor strip. **Make 4 strip sets.** Cut onto $3\frac{1}{4}$ " segments. Cut 20 of Strip E

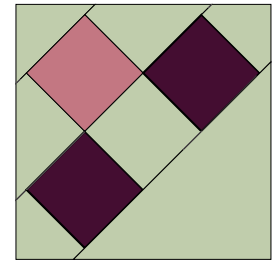


CONSTRUCTION CONTINUED:

6 Sew together one 4"x2½" sage-solid rectangle, one Strip A, one Strip C and one 10"x5¼" sage-solid rectangle to make Block A. Make 6 rose and 9 plum.



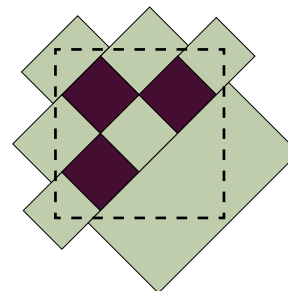
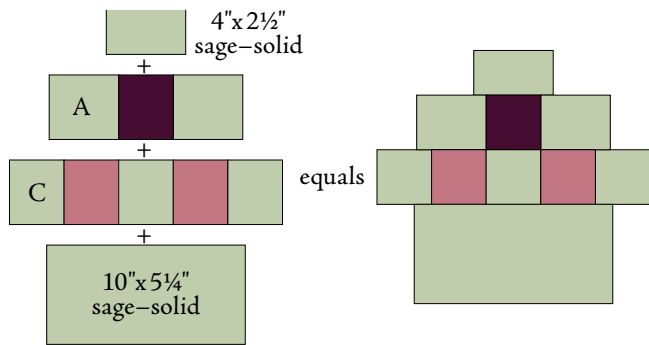
Trim to 8½"x8½".



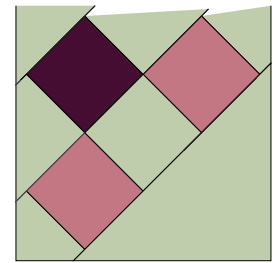

7 Sew together one 4"x2½" sage-solid rectangle, one Strip A, one Strip B and one 10"x5¼" sage-solid rectangle to make Block B. Make 2 rose and 2 plum.



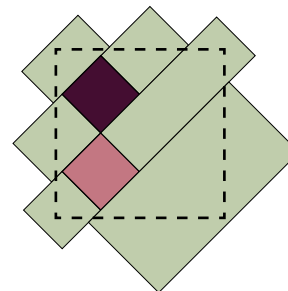
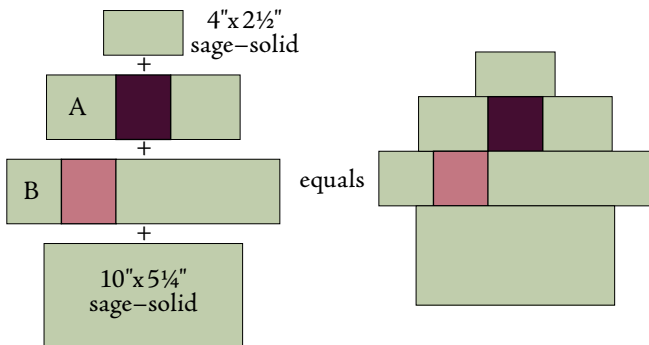
Trim to 8½"x8½".



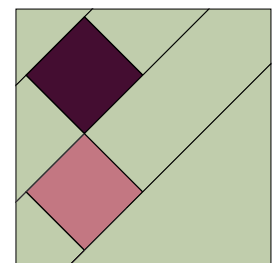

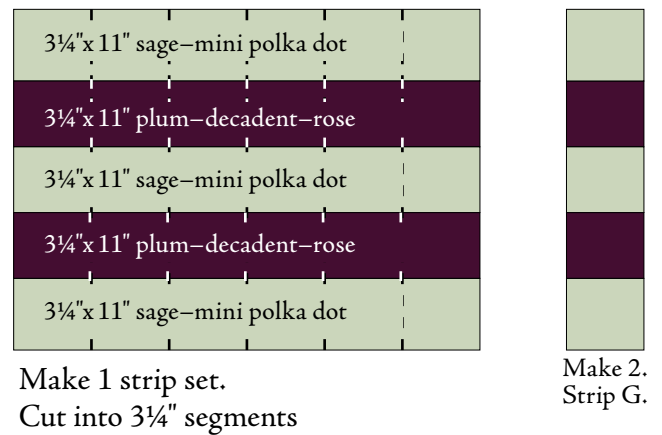
8 Sew together two 4"x2½" sage-solid rectangles, two Strip Es and one Strip D strip to make Block C. Make 10.



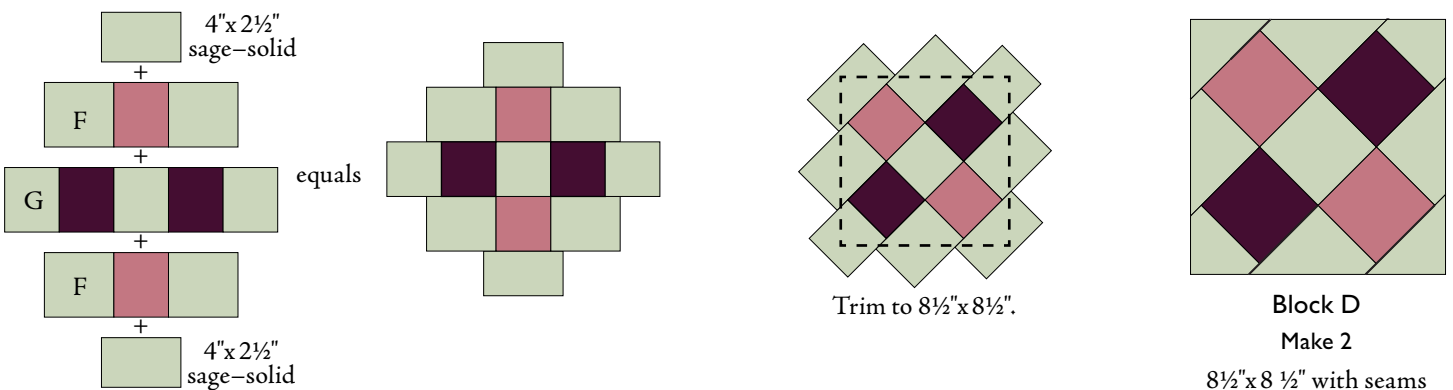
9 Sew two 3¾"x22" sage-mini polka dot strips and one 3¾"x22" rose-flower toss strip. Make one strip set. Cut onto 3¾" segments. Make 4 of Strip F.



10 Sew three 3¾"x11" sage-mini polka dot strips and two 3¾"x11" plum-decadent-rose strips. Make one strip set. Cut into 3¾" segments. Make 2 of Strip G.



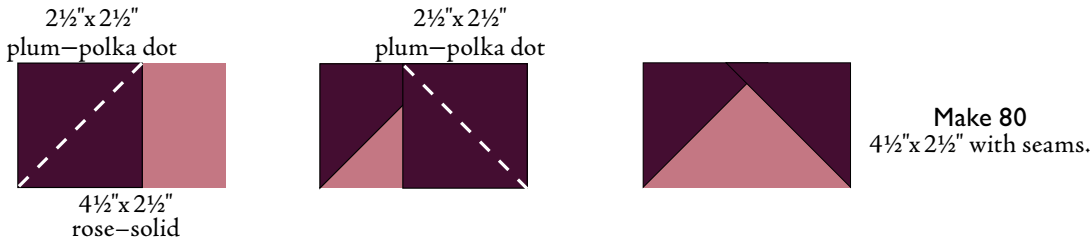
11 Sew together two 4"x2½" sage-solid rectangles, two Strip Fs and one Strip G strip to make Block D. Make 2.



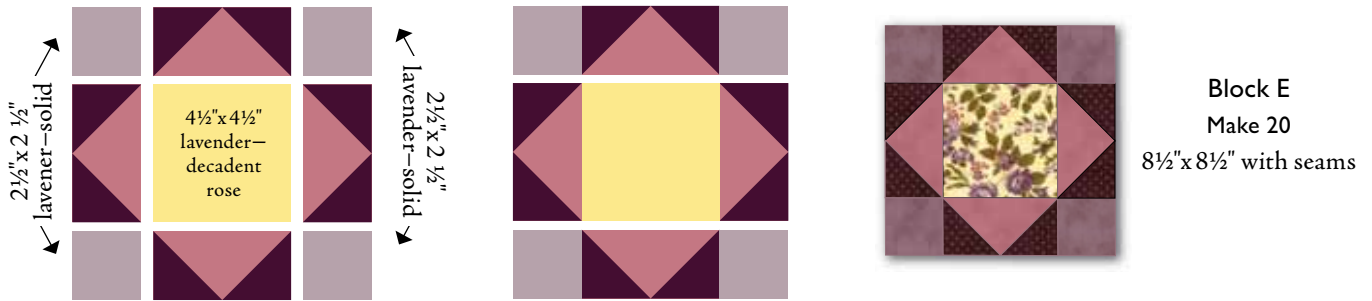
FLYING GEESSE:

Easy corner triangles will be used to make flying geese blocks.

- 1 Use two $2\frac{1}{2}$ " plum—mini polka dot squares to make easy corner triangles on $4\frac{1}{2}$ "x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " rose—solid rectangles. Make 80.



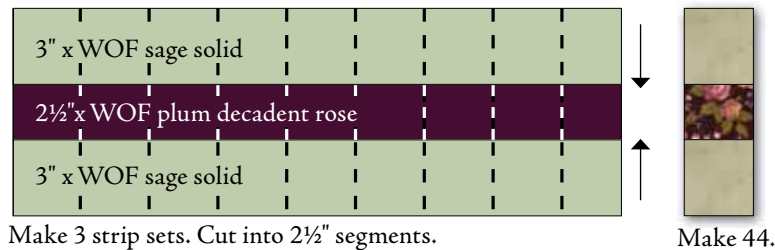
- 2 Assemble 20 blocks using four $2\frac{1}{2}$ " lavender—solid squares, one $4\frac{1}{2}$ "x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " lavender—decadent rose square and four of the previous blocks.



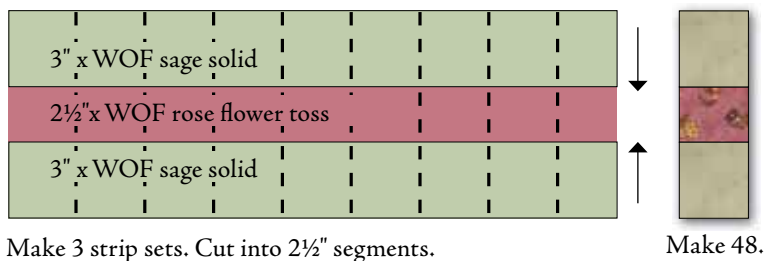
SEMINOLE PIECING:

Use seminole piecing to make the scrappy inner border.

- 1 Make strip sets using one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF plum—decadent rose strip and two 3" x WOF sage—solid strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. Make 48.

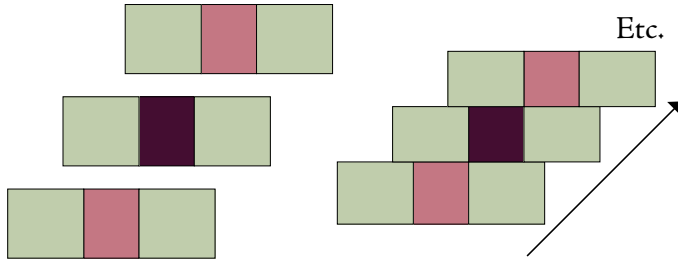


- 2 Make strip sets using one $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF rose—flower toss strip and two 3" x WOF sage—solid strips. Make 3 strip sets. Cut into $2\frac{1}{2}$ " segments. Make 48.

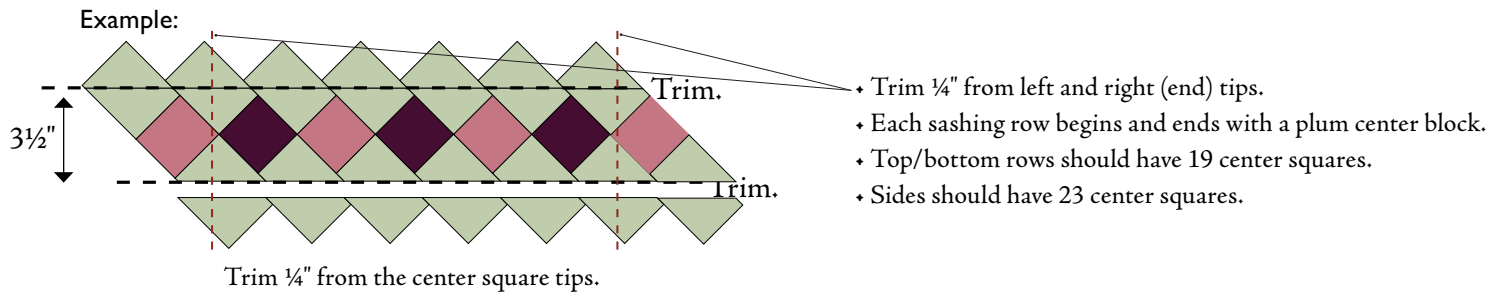


CONSTRUCTION CONTINUED:

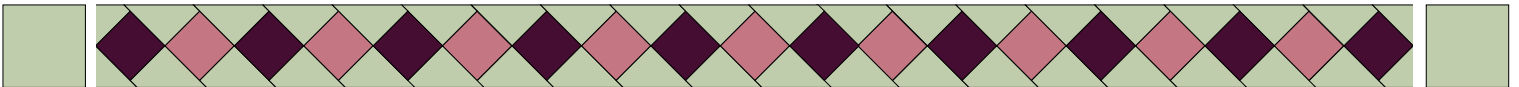
- 3 The sections will be sewn together offset as shown. For the side borders, sew together 25 segments. For the top & bottom borders, sew together 21. Begin and end with the segment with the rose flower toss center. Press all seams in the same direction.



- 4 Lay your transparent ruler $\frac{1}{4}$ inch above the tip of the center squares, and trim on both sides.



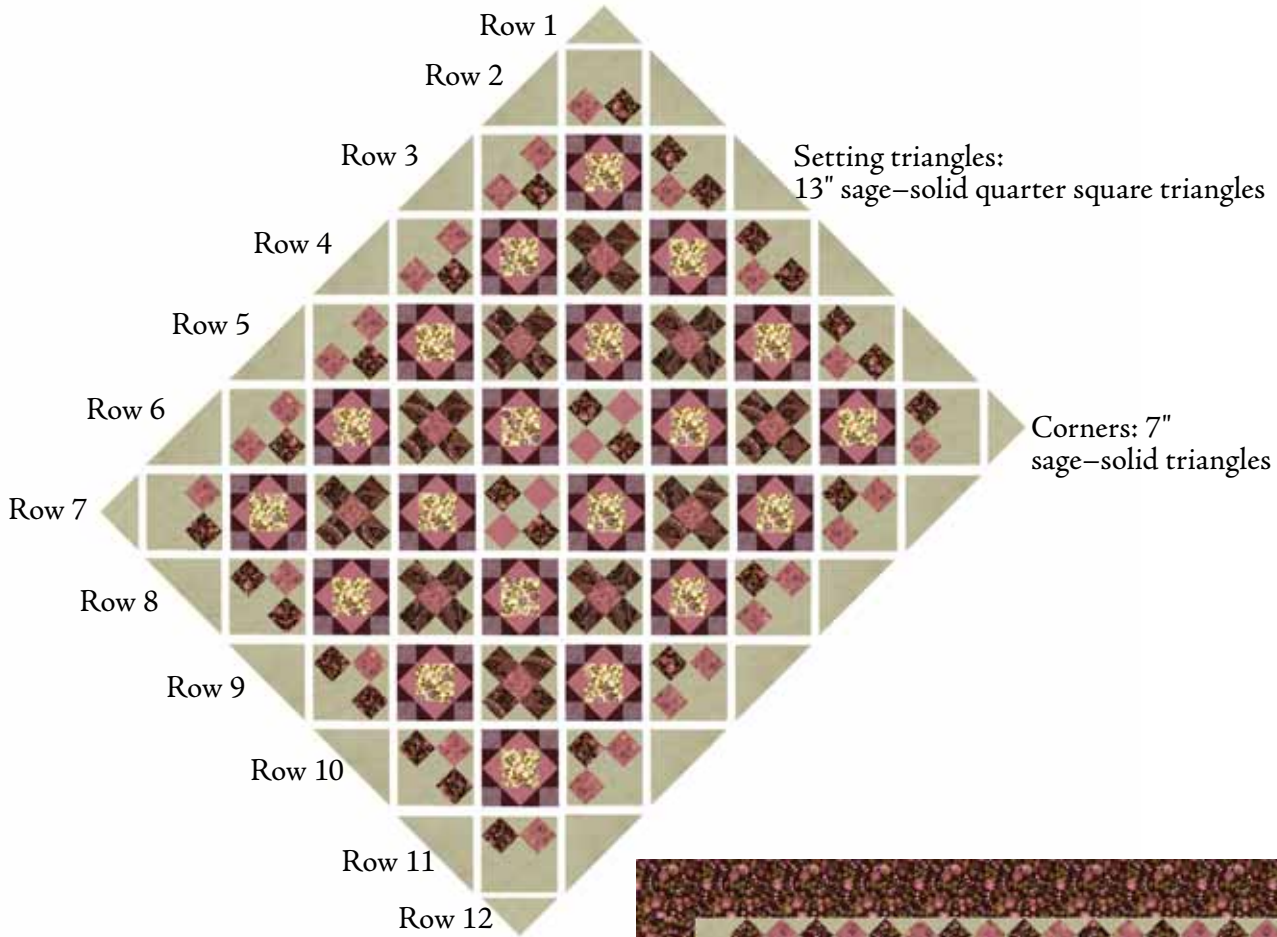
- 5 Add $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " sage—solid squares to both ends of the top and bottom borders. (19 segment borders)



ASSEMBLE QUILT TOP:

ASSEMBLING THE TOP:

Sew the rows together, pressing the rows in opposite directions.



ASSEMBLING THE TOP:

Add the scrappy inner borders, sides first than top and bottom. Repeat with the 5½" wide final borders. Layer, quilt, bind & enjoy!

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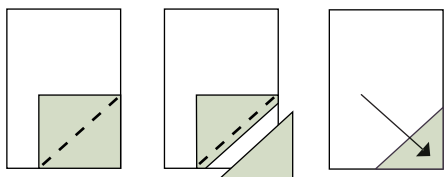

✿ QUILTERS BASICS:

- ✦ Read instructions before beginning a project.
- ✦ All instructions include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.
- ✦ WOF = width of fabric

✿ MAKING EASY CORNER TRIANGLES:



- ✦ Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the square.
- ✦ Sew on the diagonal line.
- ✦ Cut the square $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the diagonal seam.
- ✦ Press towards to the corner to form the triangle.

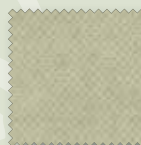
