Pattern #18606 MUL1	one panel
18607 DKBLU1	1/8 yard
18607 DKORA1	1/8 yard
18607 DKRED1	1 1/4 yards
18607 EME1	3/8 yard
18607 TAN1	1/3 yard
18608 RED1	1/3 yard
18610 CRE1.....	1 7/8 yards
	(backing)
Batting.....	45" x 63"

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. Pattern #18606 – MUL1 (calendar panel):

1. Trim panel, on all four sides, 1/4" away from the red stripe to measure 18" x 36 1/8".
2. Trim 1/4" away from the edges of the "2010" image, including the attached stars, to measure 1 3/4" x 8 7/8".

B. Pattern #18607 – DKBLU1 (geometric):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for pieced inner border.

C. Pattern #18607 – DKORA1 (geometric):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for pieced inner border.

D. Pattern #18607 – DKRED1 (geometric):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for pieced inner border.
2. Cut four 1 3/4" x 42" strips for outer border strip unit.
3. Cut six 2 1/2" x 42" strips for binding.
4. Cut three 3" x 42" strips for backing.
5. Cut four 4 1/4" squares for outer border corners.

E. Pattern #18607 – EME1 (geometric):

1. Cut one 2 1/2" x 42" strip. Crosscut sixteen 2 1/2" squares for pieced inner border.
2. Cut four 1 3/4" x 42" strips for the outer border strip unit.

F. Pattern #18607 – TAN1 (geometric):

1. Cut two 1 3/4" x 42" strips for the tan side inner border.
2. Cut two 2 3/8" x 42" strips for the tan top and bottom inner border.

[Note: The side inner border strips and the top and bottom inner border strips are cut different widths to enable the pieced inner border to fit properly.]

G. Pattern #18608 – RED1 (stripe):

1. Cut four 1 3/4" x 42" strips for the outer border strip unit.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

A. The panel unit:

1. Cut the length of the 1 3/4" tan strips equal to the length of the panel. Sew the strips to the sides of the panel. Press toward the strips.
2. Cut the length of the 2 3/8" tan strips equal to the width of the panel with the side strips. Sew to the top and bottom of the panel. Press toward the strips.

B. The pieced inner border:

1. Sew two strips of twenty 2 1/2" squares for the side pieced inner border, alternating colors as shown in the photo. Press. Sew to the sides of the panel unit. Press toward the panel unit. (Tip: If the strip is longer than the side of the panel unit, slightly increase the width of a few of the seams between the squares to adjust the length of the strip.)
2. Sew two strips of twelve 2 1/2" squares, alternating colors, for the top and bottom pieced inner border. Press. Sew to the top and bottom of the panel unit. Press toward the panel unit.

C. The outer border strip unit:

1. Make three strip sets as shown in Figure 1 by sewing three 1 3/4" strips together: one green strip, one stripe strip, and one red strip. Press toward the red and green strips.

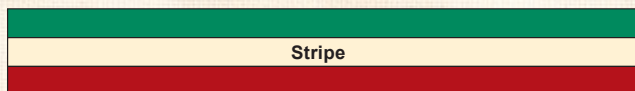

2. Cut the length of two strip sets equal to the length of the quilt. Reserve for the side borders.
3. Cut the length of the third strip set equal to the width of the quilt. Sew a 4 1/4" red square to each end. Press toward the strip set. Reserve for the bottom border.
4. The top outer border strip set:
 - a. Cut the remaining 1 3/4" stripe strip in half. Sew each half to opposite ends of the 1 3/4" x 8 7/8" 2010 strip (Figure 2). Press toward the stripe.

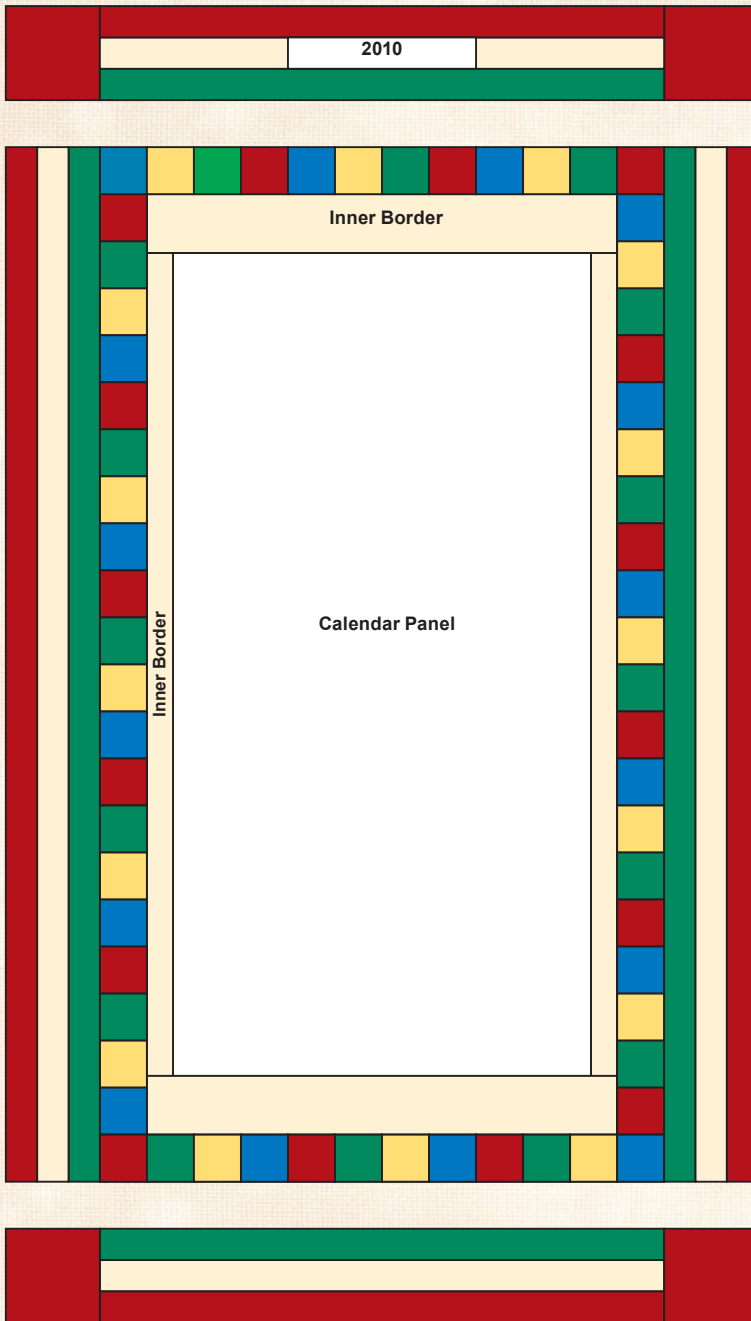

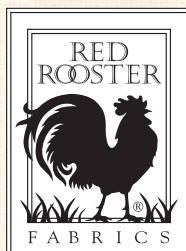
- b. Sew a 1 3/4" green strip to the bottom of the 2010 unit and a 1 3/4" red strip to the top. Press toward the red and green strips.
 - c. Match the center of the 2010 image to the center of the width of the quilt. Trim the length of the strip set equal to the width of the quilt.
 - d. Sew a 4 1/4" red square to each end of the strip set. Press toward the border unit.
5. Referring to the quilt diagram, sew the side border units to the sides of the quilt. Press toward the border units.
 6. Sew the top and bottom border units to the top and bottom of the quilt. Press toward the border units.

FINISHING:

1. Sew the three 3" red strips for the backing end to end. Cut the length in half. Sew each half to the long sides of the 1 7/8 yards of quilt backing. Press seams open.
2. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing.
3. Quilt as desired.
4. Trim layers even with the quilt top.
5. Join binding strips with diagonal seams. Attach binding to quilt using your favorite method.
6. Make a hanging sleeve and attach to the back of the quilt.
