FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

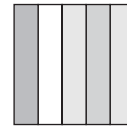
24-30 obese eighths (9" x 18") assorted lights and darks		
Appliqué background	7074-44 Gold	1-1/4 yd
Checkerboard	7077-44 Gold	1-1/4 yd
Checkerboard	7070-99 Black	1-1/4 yd
Inner Border	7075-88 Red	5/8 yd
Outer Border	7074-40 Multi Wheat	1-1/2 yd
Binding		3/4 yd
Backing		5 yds

CUTTING & CONSTRUCTION

All seams are 1/4" - wof = width of fabric

RAIL FENCE BLOCKS

- Cut (80) 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" rectangles assorted lights & darks
- Piece each block with five rectangles. Press in one direction. Make 16.

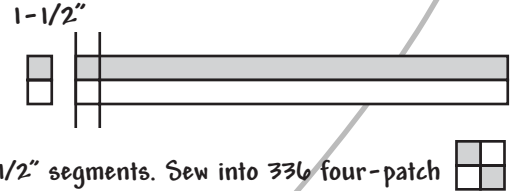


APPLIQUÉ HEART BLOCKS

- Cut (9) 11" x 11" background squares of gold 7074-44. Use the template provided to trace (9) hearts from assorted dark fabrics. Reverse the template for some of the hearts for variety. With the appliqué method of your choice, appliqué hearts to the background squares.
- After appliqué is complete, trim the squares to measure to 10-1/2" x 10-1/2".

CHECKERBOARD SASHING

- Cut (24) 1-1/2" x wof strips light
- Cut (24) 1-1/2" x wof strips dark
- Piece strips together lengthwise, press toward the dark fabric. Cross cut into 672 - 1-1/2" segments. Sew into 336 four-patch blocks.
- Piece four patches together:
 - Sew (5) four-patches together to make a 2-1/2" x 10-1/2" checkerboard strip. Make 30. These alternate with the blocks in the rows.
 - Sew (31) four-patches together into six rows. These alternate with the rows of blocks.
- Use the picture of the quilt for block placement. Piece the blocks into five rows of five blocks, alternating sashing with blocks.



INNER BORDER

- Cut (7) 2-1/2" x wof strips red 7075-88
- Piece into:
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 62-1/2" strips, sew to sides of quilt top
 - (2) 2-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips sew, to top and bottom

OUTER BORDER

- Cut (7) 5 1/2" x wof strips Multi-wheat 7074-40
- Piece into:
 - (2) 5-1/2" x 66-1/2" strips, sew to sides of quilt top
 - (2) 5-1/2" x 76-1/2" strips, sew to top and bottom

Layer, baste and quilt as desired.

Piece binding from (8) 2-1/2" strips and add to the quilt to complete.
