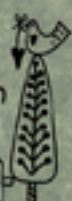

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# Hedgerow

Finished Size: 48" x 48"

## Materials

- 1/4 yard **EACH** of: blue leaves (2956-5), red check (2960-2), green check (2960-6), and green marble (2957-6).  
3/8 yard **EACH** of: blue butterflies (2954-5), blue check (2960-5), cream butterflies, (2954-3), brown floral (2958-9), and brown marble (2957-9).  
1/2 yard **EACH** of: blue floral (2958-5), brown stripe (2959-9), cream floral (2958-30), and red leaves (2956-2).  
3/4 yard of: blue stripe (2959-5).  
3 yards for quilt backing.

## Cutting

All strips are cut across the width of the fabric from selvage edge to selvage edge.

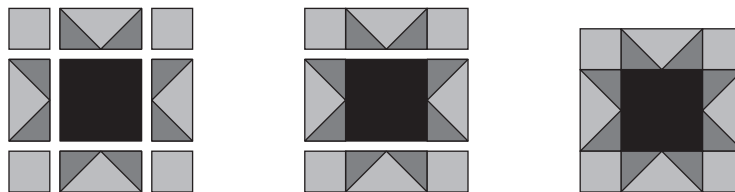
- From the blue leaves, cut:  
(4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
From the red check, cut:  
(4) 1 1/2" x 42" strips.  
From **EACH** of the green check and green marble, cut:  
(8) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
From the blue butterflies, cut:  
(12) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
From the blue check, cut:  
(4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
(4) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" pieces.  
(4) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.  
From the brown floral, cut:  
(4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
(2) 2 1/4" x 42" strips for binding.  
From the brown marble, cut:  
(8) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
(2) 2 1/4" x 42" strips for binding.  
From the blue floral, cut:  
(6) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.  
(9) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
(16) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.  
(2) 1 1/2" x 42" strips.  
From the brown stripe, cut:  
(12) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares.  
(2) 2 1/4" x 42" strips for binding.  
From the cream floral, cut:  
(6) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.  
(4) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" pieces.  
(2) 2 1/2" x 42" strips.  
From the red leaves, cut:  
(4) 2 1/2" x 42" strips.  
(8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.  
From the cream butterflies, cut:  
(10) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.  
From the blue stripe, cut:  
(10) 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" squares.  
(2) 2 1/2" x 42" strips.  
(16) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares.  
(2) 1 1/2" x 42" strips.

## Make the Large Center Star

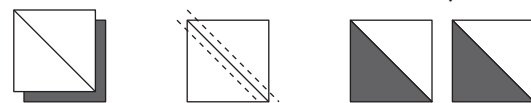
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) red leaves squares. Layer a red square with a 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" blue check piece, right sides together. Sew on the marked line. Trim leaving 1/4" seam allowance. Press the red triangle up. Repeat for the opposite end of the blue check piece to make one star point unit. Make (4).



2. Assemble (1) 4 1/2" blue floral square, (4) red star point units, and (4) 2 1/2" blue check squares together as shown to complete the block center.



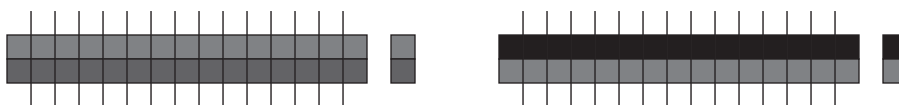
3. Using the 4 1/2" brown stripe squares and the 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" cream floral pieces, repeat the procedure from step 1 to make (4) brown star point units.  
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) 4 7/8" cream floral square. Layer the cream square with a 4 7/8" blue floral square, right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of the marked line. Cut on the line to make (2) pieced squares. Make (12).



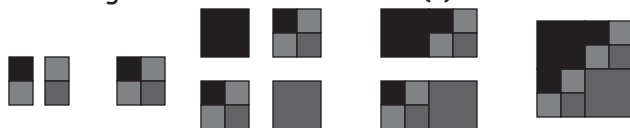
5. Sew the block center, (4) brown star point units, and (4) pieced squares together as shown to complete the large center star.

## Make the Pieced Blocks

1. Sewing lengthwise, join a 1 1/2" red check strip to a 1 1/2" blue floral strip. Make (2). Repeat this procedure to make (2) red check and blue stripe strip sets. Cut (16) 1 1/2" wide segments from each strip set.



2. Sew a blue floral segment to a blue stripe segment to make a small 4-patch. Make (32). Sew (1) 2 1/2" blue floral square, (1) 2 1/2" blue stripe square, and (2) small 4-patches together as shown to make (1) small 4-patch block. Make (16).



3. Using the 4 7/8" cream butterflies and blue stripe squares, repeat the procedure from step 4 above to make (20) pieced squares.  
4. Using the 2 1/2" red leaves, cream floral and blue stripe strips, repeat the procedure from step 1 to make (2) red and cream and (2) red and blue strip sets. Cut (12) 2 1/2" wide segments from each strip set. Repeat the procedure from step 2 to sew a cream and red segment to a blue and red segment to make (1) large 4-patch. Make (24).

## Quilt Assembly & Finishing

1. Using the quilt shown on the cover as a guide, assemble the remaining 4 1/2" squares, the large and small 4-patch blocks, and the remaining pieced squares into (12) rows each made up of (12) squares or blocks with the large center star at the center of the quilt as shown. Sew the units into rows. Sew the rows together to complete the body of the quilt top.  
2. Layer the finished quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired. Make a scrappy binding from the 2 1/4" brown strips and bind the finished quilt.
