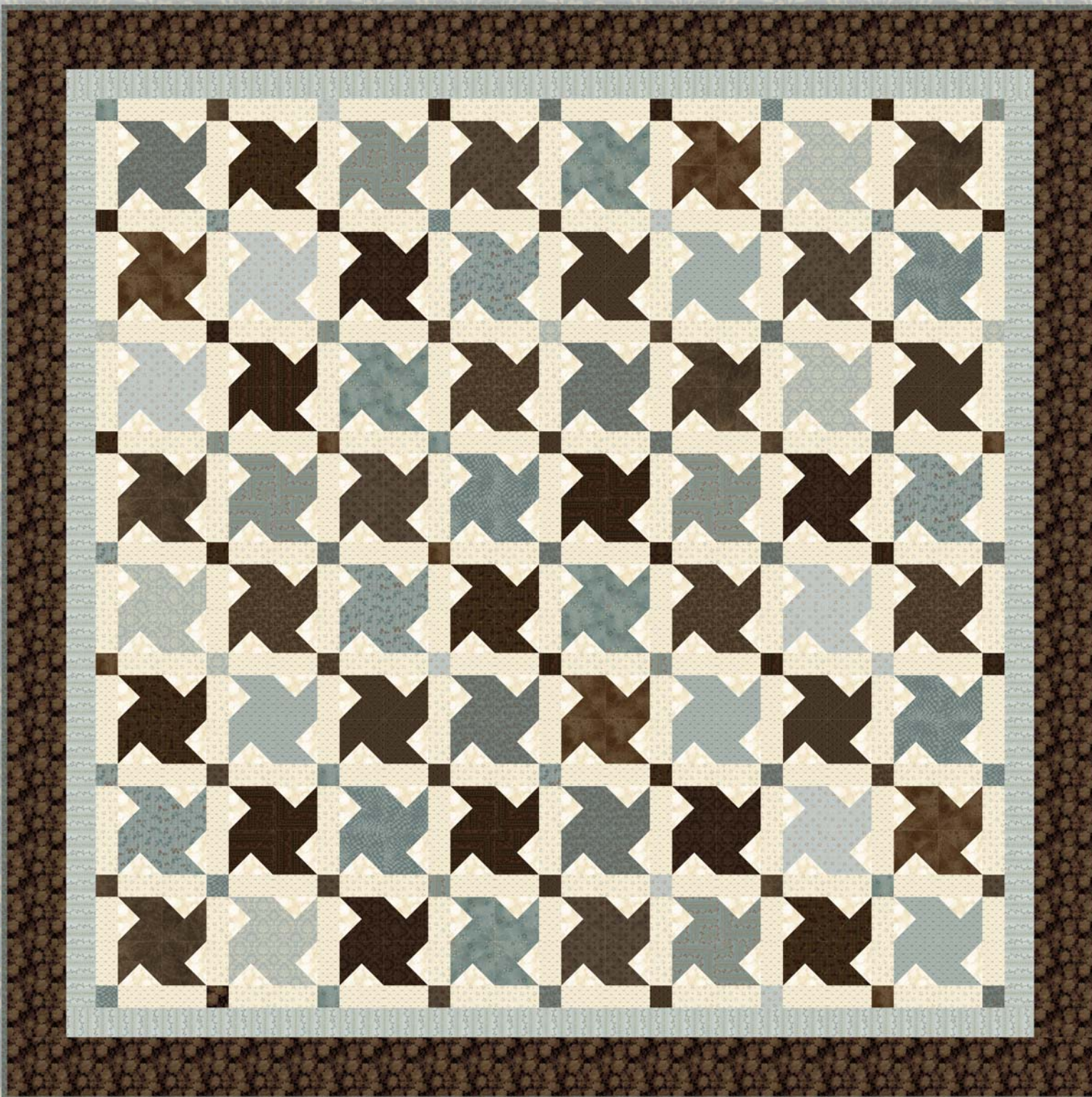

# ICED MOCHA

By the Buggy Barn for Henry Glass Co.

74" x 74"

## Fabric Requirements

- 8 fat quarters blue prints for blocks
- 8 fat quarters brown prints for blocks
- 1-1/8 yd cream floral 1905-44 for background
- 3/4 Yd cream print 1900A-41 for sashing
- 3/4 Yd cream print 1904-41 for sashing
- 3/4 yd light blue stripe 1908-17 for inner border
- 1-1/4 yd brown floral 1905-33 for outer border
- Backing 4-3/4 yard
- Binding 3/4 yard

## Cutting Requirements

Each fat quarter will make 4 blocks. You will need a total of 32 blue and 32 brown blocks

From cream floral background, cut:

- (8) 4 1/4" strips. Crosscut into (64) 4 1/4" squares. Cut twice diagonally to yield (256) quarter-square triangles.

From each of the blue and each of the brown fat quarters, cut:

- (4) 4 1/4" squares, cut twice diagonally
- (8) 3 7/8" squares, cut once diagonally
- (5) 2" squares (posts) \*

\*cut one additional blue 2" square for a total of 41 blue and 40 brown posts.

From cream prints, cut a total of:

- (144) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles (sashing)

From lt blue stripe, cut:

- (8) 2 1/2" strips for inner border

From brown floral print, cut:

- (8) 4 1/2" strips for outer border

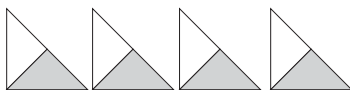
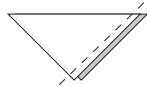
## Piecing

For each pinwheel block:

Right sides together, place a background quarter-square triangle on a print quarter-square triangle. Sew along the short side with a scant 1/4" seam.

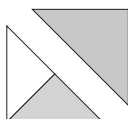
Press toward the darker print fabric. (Be careful not to stretch the fabrics.)

Make four of these units.



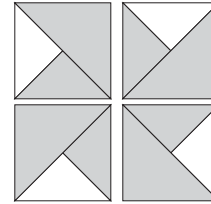
Sew each of the four units to one of the matching print half square triangles.

Press toward the darker print fabric.



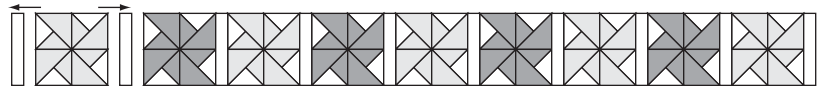
Sew the four pieced units together into a pinwheel block. The block measures 6 1/2" unfinished.

Make 32 blue pinwheels and 32 brown pinwheels.



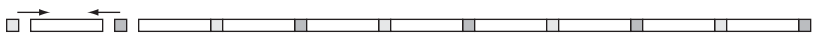
## Quilt Assembly

Row one: Beginning and ending with a sashing strip, alternate blue and brown blocks. (Begin the first row with a blue pinwheel block. Begin the next row with a brown pinwheel block. Press seams toward the sashing strips. Continue to alternate blue and brown blocks for a total of 8 rows of 8 blocks.



Sashing rows:

Begin the first sashing row with a blue square, alternate with the a brown square. Begin the second sashing row with a brown 2" square. Continue in this manner to make a total of 9 sashing rows. Press toward the sashing strips. You will have 5 rows that begin and end with a blue square and 4 rows that begin and end with a brown square.



Now, sew the rows of blocks and sashing strips together.

Inner border

From 2 1/2" strips of light blue stripe piece:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 62" inner border strips
- (2) 2 1/2" x 66" inner border strips

Sew inner border to sides of the quilt and then to the top and bottom.

Outer border

From 4 1/2" brown floral strips piece:

- (2) 4 1/2" x 66" outer border strips
- (2) 4 1/2" x 74" outer border strips

Sew outer border to sides of the quilt and then to the top and bottom.

Layer, baste, quilt and bind!!
