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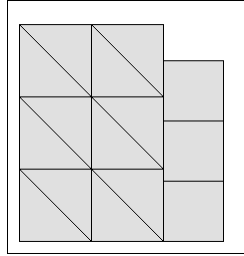

Size: 73" x 83"

Cutting Instructions:

From each **FAT QUARTER**, cut:
6 - 5 7/8" squares cut diagonally once
3 - 5" squares



From the **CREAM** fabric, cut:
20 - 1 3/4" x 44" strips.
Cut into 60 - 1 3/4" x 7 1/2" and 60 - 1 3/4" x 5"

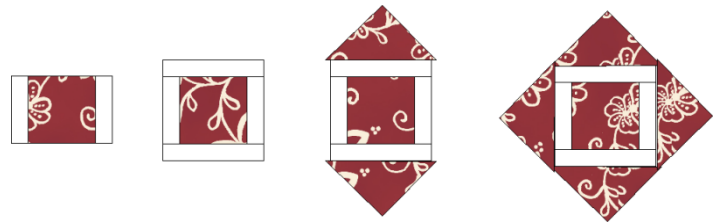
From the **RED PLAID** fabric, cut: 6 - 4" x 44" strips

From the **BROWN FLORAL** fabric, cut: 8 - 8 1/2" x 44" strips

From the **STRIPE** fabric, cut: Enough 3 1/4" wide strips on the bias to total 330" in length when sewn together

Assembly Instructions:

1. Sew a cream 1 3/4" x 5" to both sides of a colored 5" square as shown. Sew a cream 1 3/4" x 7 1/2" to the remaining sides as shown. Sew a matching colored triangle to two sides of the block as shown. Repeat on the remaining sides. The block should now measure 10 1/2".



2. Sew the blocks together into rows (six rows of five blocks in each row, referring to the color photo as needed.) Sew the rows together. The quilt should now measure 50 1/2" x 60 1/2".

3. Position ric rac on the quilt top, referring to the color photo for placement. Stitch down the center with matching color thread and tuck under the end that won't be covered by a flower. You will be able to do all of the stems except the one in the lower right corner that overlaps the outer borders. Finish that one after the borders have been added.

4. Trace the flower petal template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Press onto the back side of the red fabric. Cut out on the drawn line and peel off the paper backing. Position on the quilt and fuse into place (refer to the color picture as needed for placement). Machine appliqué around the flower. I did a blanket stitch with two strands of matching red thread.

5. Repeat Step 4, using the green fabric to add the leaves and the cream fabric to add a 1 1/4" square flower center.

6. Sew all of the red plaid strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 60 1/2" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 57 1/2" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

7. Sew all of the brown floral strips together end to end. Cut off two lengths at 67 1/2" and sew to the sides of the quilt. Cut off two lengths at 73 1/2" and sew to the top and bottom of the quilt.

8. Quilt as desired and add the bias cut binding.

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Fabric Requirements:
10 colored **FAT QUARTERS**
(I used more for a scrappier look)
1 fat quarter of **RED** for flowers (2863/2)
1/8 yard **GREEN** for leaves (2863/6)
1 1/8 yards of **CREAM** for blocks (2865/30)
7/8 yard of **RED PLAID** for inner border (2869/2)
2 yards of **BROWN FLORAL** for outer border (2862/9)
1 yard of **STRIPE** for bias cut binding (2866/3)
Backing and Batting: 78" x 89"
Ric Rac: 3 1/2 yards
Fusible Web: 1/4 yard
